Re: July 1, 2022 CalAIM Documentation Reform

California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal (CalAIM) Documentation Reform takes effect on July 1. This reform is to provide lean documentation standards to enable staff to spend less time on charting and more time with clients.

To prepare for these changes, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has partnered with California Mental Health Service Authority (CalMHSA) to provide Web-Based Documentation Training Videos and Documentation Guides for both Specialty Mental Health (SMHS) and Substance Use Services (SUS) providers.
